IUID COMPLIANCE & THE REGISTRY

When military contracts include the UID clause, DFARS 252.211-7003 ITEM IDENTIFICATION AND VALUATION, they (1) cite the full text, (2) note the clause, or (3) reference the DFARS solicitation provision.

In all instances where the UID clause is included, you're on the hook for applying UID labels to all items when:

- The unit acquisition cost is \$5,000 or more
- The item is serially managed
- The item is mission essential or controlled inventory. It may be repairable, consumable or a component
- The program manager has determined UID is required

PACKAGING

MIL Preservation, Packaging, Packing and Marking - Preservation, Packaging, Packing and Marking shall be in accordance with the Contract/Purchase Order Schedule and as specified below.

MIL-STD 2073 PACKAGING APPLIES AS FOUND ELSEWHERE IN THE SCHEDULE

**252.211-7003
ITEM UNIQUE IDENTIFICATION AND VALUATION (MAR 2018)**

(a) Definitions. As used in this clause-

"Automatic identification device" means a device, such as a reader or interrogator, used to retrieve data encoded on machine-readable media.

"Concatenated unique item identifier" means-

(1) For items that are serialized within the enterprise identifier, the linking together of the unique identifier data elements in order of the issuing agency code, enterprise identifier, and unique serial number within the enterprise identifier; or

(2) For items that are serialized within the original part, lot, or batch number, the linking together of the unique identifier data elements in order of the issuing agency code; enterprise identifier; original part, lot, or batch number; and serial number within the original part, lot, or batch number.

"Data matrix" means a two-dimensional matrix symbology, which is made up of square or, in some cases, round modules arranged within a particular finder pattern and uses the Error Checking and Correction 200 (ECC200) specification found within International Standards Organization (ISO)/International Electrotechnical Commission (IEC) 16022.

"Data qualifier" means a specified character (or string of characters) that immediately precedes a data field that defines the general category or intended use of the data that follows.

"DoD recognized unique identification equivalent" means a unique identification method that is in commercial use and has been recognized by DoD. All DoD recognized unique identification equivalents are listed at http://www.acq.osd.mil/dpap/pdf/uid/uid_equivalents.html

"DoD item unique identification" means a system of marking items delivered to DoD with unique item identifiers that have machine-readable data elements to distinguish an item from all other like and unlike items. For items that are serialized within the enterprise identifier, the unique item identifier shall include the data elements of the enterprise identifier and a unique serial number. For items that are serialized within the part, lot, or batch number within the enterprise identifier, the unique item identifier shall include the data elements of the enterprise identifier, the original part, lot or batch number, and the serial number.

"Enterprise" means the entity (e.g., a manufacturer or vendor) responsible for assigning unique item identifiers to items.

(2) The clause is noted

NOTE: The requirements in DFARS 252.211-7003, Item Identification and Valuation, are applicable for this line item. The contractor shall provide DoD unique identification or a DoD recognized unique identification equivalent.

(3) The DFARS solicitation provision is included by reference

52.252-2 CLAUSES INCORPORATED BY REFERENCE (FEB 1998) FAR

IUID REGISTRY SUBMISSION

Compliance with MIL-STD-130 also requires submission of UID data to the IUID Registry (Item Unique Identification). The IUID Registry database allows the DoD to keep track of maintenance and warranty records for assets around the globe. The item UID serves as the key for each record.

Submission of UID data is done at the Procurement Integrated Enterprise Environment (PIEE) website through Wide Area Workflow (WAWF). You do this when entering information into your Receiving Report and Invoice Combo. Once input, the data flows automatically to the IUID Registry.

In addition to the Original Part Number, Enterprise CAGE Code and Serial Number, other required data includes UID Type, Warranty, and Special Tooling or Test Equipment Status.
